

Five years ago, a group of East Hartford alumni, parents, teachers, and supporters gathered together to identify ways that we could support students and staff in East Hartford Public Schools. We each shared a sense of pride and appreciation for our educational experiences and the ways we wanted to give back to the next generation of East Hartford students and the educators who support them. Our meeting led to the founding of the East Hartford Alumni Association and Education Foundation.

Over our first five years we have worked to support our mission in three primary ways:

MENTORING:

Leveraging the East Hartford alumni network to mentor current students

NETWORKING:

Creating meaningful alumni-to-alumni connections to grow social networks

FUNDRAISING:

Raising funds to enhance the educational experiences of East Hartford students

With the incredible support of community members like you, we are making a difference for our students and our entire school community.

Through our first five years of work we have:

- Awarded \$82,710 in scholarships to 49 exceptional graduates of East Hartford Public Schools.
- Awarded \$17,170 in grants to 33 teachers and staff across East Hartford Public Schools.
- Recruited alumni speakers for career and community service days.
- Coordinated community networking events at area businesses.

We have accomplished so much in our first five years, and we are excited to continue our efforts to support East Hartford's students, teachers, and staff. OVER THE PAST FIVE YEARS WE HAVE AWARDED \$82,710 TO 49 GRADUATES OF EAST HARTFORD PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Through your financial support, coupled with the generous donations from committed alumni, the following scholarships have been established and distributed:

EAST HARTFORD ALUMNI ASSOCIATION AND EDUCATION FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

(Awarded 2000-2024) Offered annually to up to five graduating students pursuing an undergraduate degree or a vocational training program.

- EAST HARTFORD ALUMNI LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP

 (Established in 2024) Offered to East Hartford Public School graduates who are actively pursuing an undergraduate degree; a certification through a vocational training program; or a graduate or professional degree.
- ALICEA SCHOLARSHIP FOR REDEFINING NORMS

 (Awarded 2021-2024) Offered to an aspiring first-generation college student. Primary sponsor: Beatrice Alicea-Martin (EHHS class of 2010) along with other friends and family

The EHAAEF, through their annual Grants program, supported the students at EHMS to build cultural sensitivity and awareness by playing sports from around the world. The Health/PE teachers who received this grant were able to create a unit and purchase equipment to allow students in all grade levels to experience different cultures through sports and games. We all learned how sports can vary between different countries, but that people from all cultures can build positive relationships and a healthy community through physical activity. The students really enjoyed the International Games unit, and we have added it to the regular Health/PE curriculum going forward.









One of the major questions our music department asked ourselves coming out of the pandemic was, "what are the essential experiences we need to create for our East Hartford students for them to truly commit and buy into a culture of music-making?" We made some important progress to establish culturally responsive content and practices, with a big emphasis on student-directed creative output. The funding from the East Hartford Alumni Foundation has allowed us to create a community performance setting outside of the school building for our EHMS and EHHS students, bringing them in contact with exceptional professional musicians who become role models and who show our students the possibilities they can achieve if they commit to creative practices on their instruments. Our students are thriving as they create new music out in the East Hartford community thanks to the opportunities afforded by the East Hartford Alumni Foundation.

The drones purchased through the EHAAEF Grant allowed students to transform a hypothetical unit on beluga whale transport into a real-life experience. Students were eager to learn the content and skills needed to contribute to a successful beluga transport simulation using drones. Students were interested in continuing their work after school, which contributed to the development of a full after-school STEM program for the coming school year. We look forward to extending the beluga transport project to investigate the effects of other measurements (transport time, altitude, speed, turbulence), and incorporating the drones into other STEM units. I look forward to continuing and growing this project every year.






